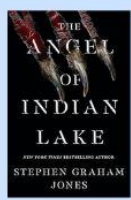


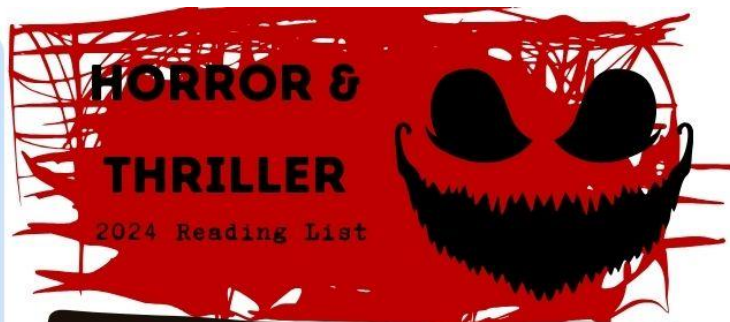
Title: The Graveyard Shift

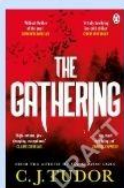


Title: The Angel of Indian Lake

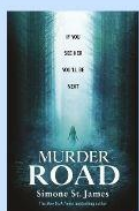

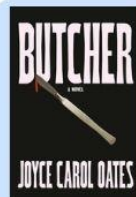
Title: The Gathering

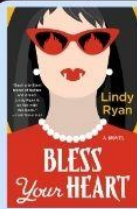

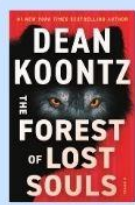
Title: Myrrh

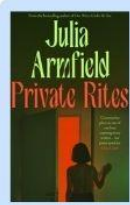
Title: Our Wicked Histories
