

Jana Monroe was one of the first analysts and, at the time, the only female agent-in the world-renowned FBI Behavioral Sciences Unit at Quantico, consulted on more than 850 homicide cases, including infamous serial killers Ted Bundy, Jeffrey Dahmer, Edmund Kemper, and Aileen Wuornos. Monroe was the model for Clarice Starling in the movie version of The Sillence of the Lambs; she even helped train Jodie Foster for her Oscarwinning role. Monroe's later years found her dealing with the aftermath of Columbine, heading up the FBI's post-9/11 investigation and much more.






